The Certificate in General Education program consists of 33 credits that may be selected in consultation with an academic advisor or counselor to ensure they are appropriate to meet the student's transfer and educational goals. The Certificate is not intended to represent a comprehensive general education core or to insure the same ease of transferability as the transfer degrees.
